

# ConKerr Cancer: A Case for Smiles

We need people willing to:

- Donate 100% cotton fabric of color and design that would appeal to children from infancy through high school and to boys and to girls who have to spend time in hospitals for treatment of cancer
- Donate quart-sized Ziploc bags for completed cases
- Cut fabric and piece it for sewing
- Sew cases
- Spread the word to others (relatives, friends, church members) who might also like to become involved

## How to Make a Pillowcase:

Supplies:

- 3/4 yard cotton fabric for body of case
- 1/3 yard complimentary cotton fabric for border

Sewing Instructions:

- Cut the body of the case 26 ½ inches x 40 ½ inches
- Cut the border of the case 10 ½ inches x 40 ½ inches
- Fold the border in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and iron/press the fold
- Place the right side of the border on the right side of the body of the case, and stitch together, using ½ inch seam allowance
- Place right sides together of the pillowcase, and stitch down the side and across the bottom, using ½ inch seam allowance
- Turn completed case right side out and iron/press

Finished Pillowcase:

- Wash and iron/press
- Place inside a quart-sized Ziploc bag
